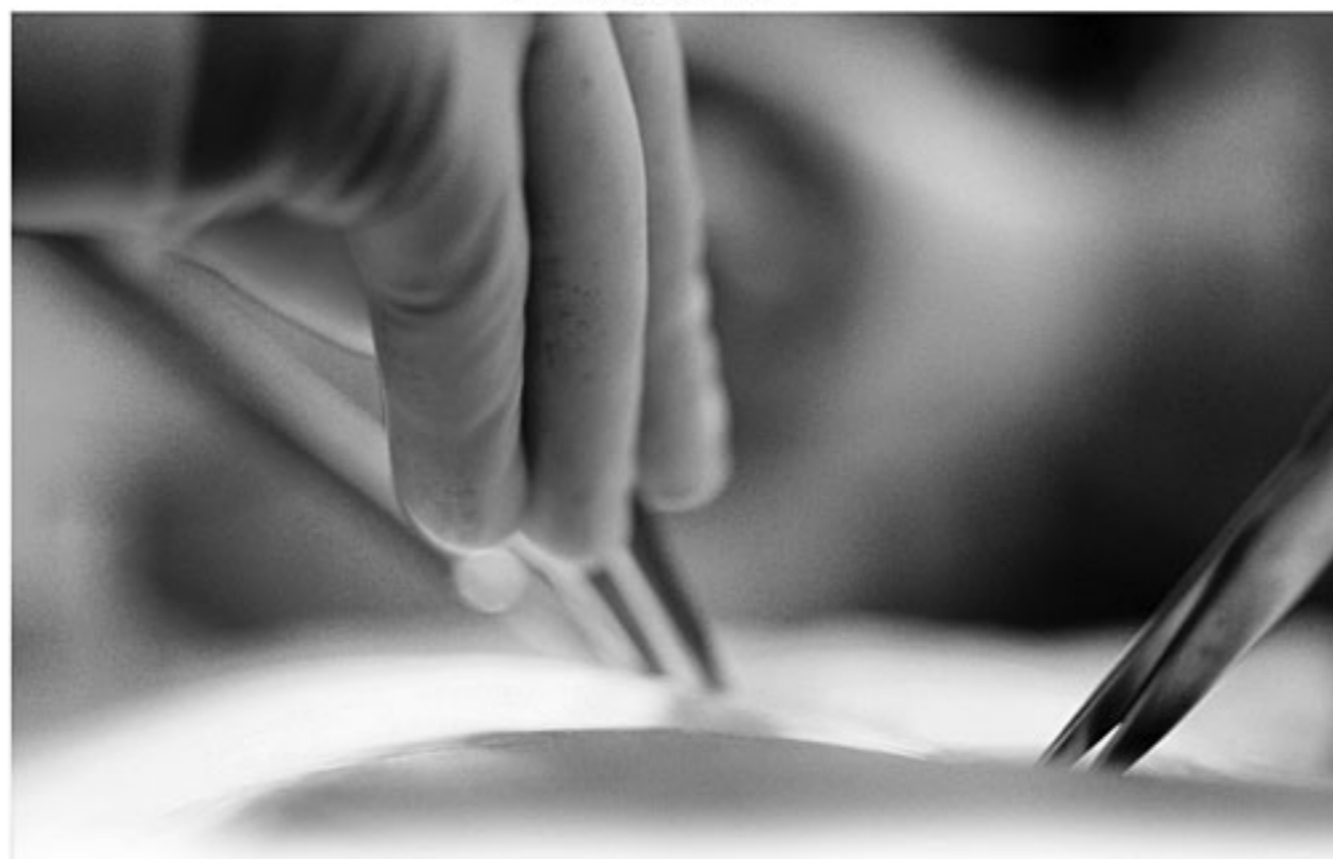

We do survey attendees annually for self-report data, and also report composite seminar evaluation scores to AAPA.
